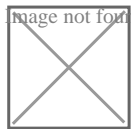

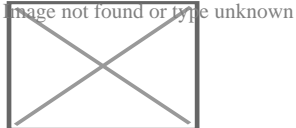
In Memoriam Retired Ambassador Wolfgang Schallenberg

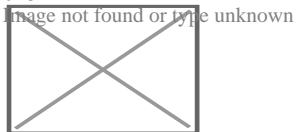
