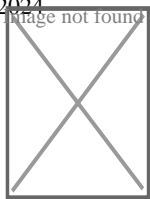

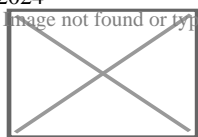


It was with great sadness that we received the news that Käthe Sasso, resistance fighter and contemporary eyewitness, has passed away at the age of 98.
