The prize is endowed annually with a total of € 30,000 and is awarded in the following categories:

**Civic engagement to promote  
Holocaust education**  
€ 7,500

**Main Prize**  
€ 15,000

Special consideration will be given to projects, initiatives and achievements, that

- ◆ create fresh impetus and place new accents.
- ◆ set an example for others.
- ◆ have a lasting impact on the present and the future.
